What is a School Based Health Center?

Think of it as a doctor's office in the school. We can see your child during school hours for acute illness, chronic health problems, physicals, and immunizations. We can provide prescriptions, lab services, and referrals for specialty services if needed.

Will my child have to miss class for a visit and do I need to be there?

Your child will be taken out of class for 20-30 minutes for a visit depending on the illness or health issue. We will work with your child's teacher so we don't interrupt their critical instruction time. We also have after school hours available. You are welcome to come to the school and accompany your child for visits if you want to, but it is not required.

What kind of health problems can you see?

Acute illnesses like sore throats, earaches, upset stomach, headaches, runny nose, sinus infection, flu, sprains, etc. Chronic health problems like asthma, diabetes, high blood pressure, allergies, etc. We also do physicals for sports and well child exams.

Do you need permission to see my child?

Yes, you will need to complete an enrollment form giving us permission to treat your child along with providing us important health history about your child. This form is available in the school office or at www.communitycarewv.org.

Will you contact me if my child is seen at the Health Center?

Absolutely! If your child needs to be seen for an unscheduled acute care visit, we will attempt to contact you by phone first. If we are unable to reach you, we will send home a summary of the visit. For scheduled appointments we will call or send home a note depending on your preference and availability.

What if my child already has a doctor?

If your child already has a doctor for chronic care, we can see them for acute problems as needed. We can, with your permission, send information to their regular provider to keep them informed.

How do I pay for my child's visit?

We accept most insurance including Medicaid, Medicare, and CHIPS. We also offer an income based sliding scale. Your child will not be charged at the visit. Insurance will be billed, or we will send a bill to you.

How do I set up an appointment?

Appointments are not necessary, you can send a note with your child requesting that they be seen on the days the health center is open. If you would prefer an appointment so you can accompany your child, contact our main office at 304-745-4568 and request the school based clinic.
