Policy 2209 - Child Nutrition Programs

The purpose of this policy to establish procedures to provide for necessary facilities and personnel to operate a child nutrition program, including school breakfast, lunch and after school snack programs.

- 2209.1 Each student in the school district shall have the opportunity to secure a lunch and breakfast in all respective Harrison County schools.
- 2209.2 All meals and snacks served shall meet the nutritional requirements mandated by state and federal law.
- 2209.3 Harrison County's child nutrition programs shall serve nutritionally sound meals and snacks at a charge that reflects the cost of the food services offered.
- 2209.4 All Harrison County schools shall offer free and reduced price meals for qualified students.
- 2209.5 The superintendent of schools and his designated representatives shall be responsible for operating a fiscally sound child nutrition program.
- 2209.6 The superintendent of schools shall recommend for appointment the necessary personnel to initiate and maintain quality school meals and snacks and to operate efficiently the food services program.
- 2209.7 All sanitation standards required by law shall be strictly observed in all locations used in the implementation of the child nutrition program. This shall include, but not be limited to physical examination requirements of employees, preparation procedures, conditions of kitchens and dining areas, maintenance procedures, and contracted storage areas.
- 2209.8 This program shall be operated in accordance with United States Department of Agriculture policy prohibiting discrimination on the basis of race, color, sex, age, handicap, religion, or national origin.
