**Section 2300 – Facility Administration**

**Policy 2301 –Vandalism and Crime Protection**

The purpose of this policy is to establish procedures to ensure protection of Harrison County Board of Education property from acts of vandalism and to otherwise protect the board's property.

- 2301.1 - It shall be declared trespassing for any unauthorized person, to be present upon any school or other board of education property or to loiter around school buildings or on school campuses. The school administration is hereby authorized to seek aid from any appropriate police agency as reasonably deemed necessary in the event unauthorized persons are present on school property.
- 2301.2 - The school administration is hereby authorized to press any criminal charges deemed appropriate through the appropriate law enforcement agency for any activity reasonably believed to be criminal in nature.
- 2301.3 - The Harrison County Board of Education shall cooperate fully with any prosecution to the fullest extent of the law of any person charged with any acts of vandalism.
- 2301.4 - Parents or guardians shall be held responsible for payment of all damages to persons or property and for replacement of stolen items should their child commit acts of vandalism, theft or other criminal acts on board of education property.
