Section 4300 Voter Registration

Policy 4301 Student Voter Registration Policy

4301.1 Introduction and Purpose

- 4301.1.1 Every high school student eligible by age for voter registration shall be afforded the opportunity to vote.
- 4301.1.2 The purpose of this policy is to ensure that each student eligible by age shall be provided with the opportunity to vote.

4301.2 Definitions

- 4301.2.1 “Students eligible by age” - a student who has reached his/her eighteenth birthday, or, in an election, year, who shall attain that age on or before the date of the general election.

4301.3 Responsibilities

- 4301.3.1 The Harrison County Board of Education shall provide an opportunity to register to vote for students eligible to register in each of its high schools, vocational center and adult education center
- 4301.3.2 The Harrison County Board of Education shall make arrangements with the county clerk’s office for periodic on-site voter’s registration, at a minimum, two (2) per year.
- 4301.3.3 In an election year, registration for students eligible by age shall be provided at least thirty (30) days prior to the primary election.
- 4301.3.4 The Harrison County Board of Education shall document all dates that the county clerk’s office provided on-site registration to ensure compliance with this policy.

4301.4 Review

- 42.3.4.1 The Board shall review the operation of this policy on the first anniversary of its enactment and at least every three years thereafter.
