### SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENT SCHEDULE

The Summative Assessment will begin for 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grades at Adamston Elementary on Thursday, April 25<sup>th</sup>. Each child will take an ELA (English Language Arts) and Math section. Only fifth grade will complete a Science section as well. A schedule has been created to ensure every child in 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grades will have ample time and opportunity to do their best on the assessment.

Please make sure your child gets plenty of rest the nights prior to testing. Arriving on time is essential! If an absence or tardy occurs, they will make up the missed test in a separate location from their classmates, lose instructional time when completing the missed section and fail to receive a ticket towards winning a bike.
