## Dress Code for Commencement Activities

**GIRLS:** Dress only (no longer than your gown) – No shorts or slacks. Dress shoes only: no tennis shoes, sport shoes, or flip flops. If possible, shoes should be black or white. If you are wearing a white gown, wear a white dress or a very light- colored dress with no pattern.

**BOYS:** White button-up dress shirt with collar. Tie of your choice. Black dress slacks, black socks, and black dress shoes. No tennis shoes or sport shoes.

### Mandatory Practices:

On the calendar, starred (\*) practices are mandated. If you plan to attend the ceremony, you must attend the practice. Plan your work schedule so you will be available for the entire practice and ceremony.

Note: Seniors must meet all graduation requirements to participate in any ceremony where a graduation gown is worn.

Those who do not conform to this dress code will not walk at graduation.  
They will receive their diploma the week AFTER graduation from the school office.

## Brief Description of Graduation Events

**Sr Banquet:** This is attended by graduating seniors. It includes a catered meal and the showing of the senior video. Dues must be paid in full to attend. A \$10 deposit is required. The deposit is returned upon attendance to the banquet. Required attire is dressy (i.e. dress, slacks, dress shoes).

**Honors Assembly:** This is attended by graduating seniors, family, and friends. No tickets are required. Academic honors such as 4.0's, promise scholars, NHS, and Honor Students are recognized. Many college scholarship presentations are made, and a variety of foundation and business scholarships are awarded. All graduates are encouraged to attend. Students wanting extra graduation tickets will receive them after this program in the cafeteria. Graduation gowns must be worn at this assembly.

**Baccalaureate:** This is attended by graduating seniors, family, and friends. No tickets are required. The program is a blessing over the graduating class. It includes music, poetry, scripture readings, and 'Words of Wisdom' by special guest speakers. Graduation gowns must be worn at this assembly.

**Commencement:** This is attended by graduating seniors, family, and friends. Tickets are required for this event (a small child being held on a lap does not require a ticket). The program includes graduation speeches and the awarding of diplomas. Graduation caps & gowns must be worn at this event, and students are encouraged to wear all medals and cords received at the Honors Assembly.
