Note:

- The Spanish alphabet has 30 letters. The English alphabet has only 26.
- The four extra letters are: ch, ll, ñ, and rr.
- Words beginning with k or w are of foreign origin.
- There are no words that begin with rr.
- The letter H is always silent and is the only silent letter in Spanish.
- The letter J makes the H sound.
- The letter G makes the H sound before the letters E and I.
- Accent marks occur only on vowels (á é í ó ú), the tilde occurs as a part of the letter ñ. Both accent marks and the tilde are a necessary part of Spanish spelling.
