As per WV State Code (Law), 18-5-16A, regarding transfer requests involving two counties, **both** Boards of Education must approve transfers of non-resident students. Harrison County Schools **will not** assume responsibility for transportation and/or expenses relating to this transfer.

For transfers **outside** of Harrison County, parents must complete form from the other county, complete a Harrison County transfer form, have principal sign and date. Both county transfer forms must be completed and stapled together. *At any time during the school year, if the class size in the school exceeds the state student/teacher ratio limit, the student may have to return to his/her home county.*

For transfers **within** Harrison County, parents need to complete transfer form at the school they wish their child to attend and have principal sign. If approved and signed by principal, parent then takes the transfer form to their child's home school for that principal's signature. That principal will sign, date, and forward to the county office to be processed.

All **initial** transfers are approved contingent on good behavior, faithful attendance, and academic achievement, and must be in compliance with state student/teacher ratio. Transfers remain in effect unless rescinded by the Harrison County Board of Education.

Eligibility for all extra-curricular activities is governed by the West Virginia Secondary Schools Activity Commission.

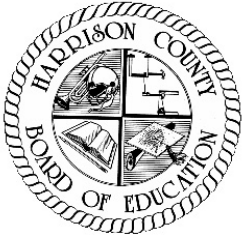

Beginning with the 2015-2016 school year, requests by parents for their child(ren) to attend a school that is other than their home area school will NOT be required annually. **Once a request has been granted by the Harrison County Board of Education, a student shall complete his/her education at that out-of-area school through the completion of that school's academic level.** (ex: through 5th grade, through 8th, through graduation.)

Student attendance areas are clearly defined and school staffing, Title I funding allocations, budget distribution, and transportation routing are all dependent on individual school enrollments.

Initial requests must be approved by the home area school principal as well as the principal of the school for which the enrollment is requested. Student attendance, academic effort, and school discipline will be reviewed and considered before requests are approved.
