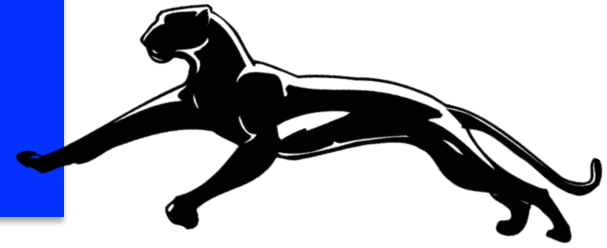

Adamston Elementary was fortunate to have the opportunity to apply and receive funding from Intermediate Unit 1, which consists of Claude Worthington Benedum, Chevron, and EQT in the amount of \$7,500. Also, Dr. Manchin and the School Board deserve a big thank you for matching those funds. \$15,000 will enable our school to do so much for our entire student population.

Our project will consist of expanding on our already existing STEAM room. The first major upgrade was a promethean board. All teachers also contributed items they had in their individual rooms, which would be useful in various STEAM projects. Making our space into a STUDIO that is “PAWSITIVE” for students is the focus. We plan on using the majority of the funds from the grant to purchase a Maker Space Cart that is fully loaded with materials to have our STUDIO up and running after the teachers receive professional development on how to lead and guide students through a STEAM lesson. We want to foster students working collaboratively as well as develop new knowledge and authentic connections that will transcend the disciplines, as they question and explore the world through active learning activities that include concepts of inquiry.
