

## Harrison County Fall 2020 Dual Credit Course Registration Information

### General Requirements:

- 1) Principal approval
- 2) Cumulative High School GPA of 3.0 verified by transcripts
- 3) ACT Score English – 18; Math – 19 OR  
SAT Score EBRW – 480; Math – 500

### Additional Institution Specific Instructions:



- 1) *Harrison County approved college classes from MU:* Math 127(Online College Algebra) with high school facilitators and Journalism 101(Dual Credit Advanced Journalism) with Mr. Bode at RCBHS
- 2) Math 127(Online College Algebra) – Students must have passed Algebra 2 with a “C” or better.
- 3) Complete the Early College Credit Application, provided by your school, and submit it to your counselor by **June 1, 2020**. Your class level should reflect your status as of Fall 2020.
- 4) Your counselor will then prepare your transcripts to verify your 3.0 GPA and create a recommendation letter to send to Marshall along with your completed application.
- 5) Register for and take the ACT on June 13, 2020, with registration deadline is **May 8**, and be sure to include Marshall University on your list of schools to automatically receive your ACT scores. You will not be admitted without the proper test scores received in a timely manner.
- 6) Your \$75 payment to Harrison County Schools will be collected when school starts in August. DO NOT pay Marshall University directly if you receive any bill from them.



Registration for Harrison County approved WVU, Pierpont C&TC, and Glenville State courses will take place on **August 3rd and August 4<sup>th</sup>** at the Harrison County Board of Education in the main board room. Your \$75 payment to Harrison County Schools will be due at the time of registration.

*Harrison County approved college courses from WVU:* Biology 101 and \*Calculus 153. **\*NOTE:** Students interested in taking WVU Calculus 153 must transfer their transcripts from Marshall University to WVU in order to verify successful completion of College Algebra and College Trigonometry from MU.

*Harrison County approved college classes from Pierpont Community and Technical College(Caperton Center):* English 1104, Political Science 1101, Psychology 1101, Medical Terminology 1100, \*Aviation Maintenance 1101, and \*Aviation Maintenance 1102. **\*NOTE** – students that are interested in the Aviation Maintenance program should visit the Robert C. Byrd National Aerospace Education Center to gain more specific details on their requirements. Please contact your counselor for specific information about meeting graduation requirements. Be sure to take the June 13 or July 18 ACT in order to qualify for the English 1104 class.

*Harrison County approved college classes from Glenville State College:* Chemistry 101 at SHHS only.
