HARRISON COUNTY SCHOOLS RESTART PLAN

IN-PERSON LEARNING

OPTION #1

LEVEL I: ALL NORMAL (All students return to a normal schedule.)

Classes and operations will return to the status observed prior to March 16, 2020, on a regular schedule.

LEVEL II: MINIMAL TO MILD COMMUNITY SPREAD (Students return and follow guidelines 5 days/week.)

Governor Justice will determine any move to remote learning for a school or county temporarily due to increases in COVID-19 cases impacting the school community.

STAGGERED START DATES:

Beginning September 8, 2020 through September 21, 2020, Harrison County Schools will follow the schedule below and reassess at 2 week increments.

Table with 5 columns: MONDAY (Grades 1, 6, 9 only), TUESDAY (Grades 2, 7, 10 only), WEDNESDAY (Grades 3, 8, 11 only), THURSDAY (Grades 4, 12, & Pre-K only), FRIDAY (Grades 5 and K only)

- Students will arrive on a 1-hour delay daily
• Students will be released 30 minutes early daily
• Postpone/cancel all unnecessary travel, assemblies, etc.
• 50% capacity in cafeteria for student lunches
• Provide physical guides to remain 6 ft. apart
• Wear mandatory face-coverings (Grades 3 - 12) when social distancing is not available

LEVEL III: MODERATE TO SUBSTANTIAL COMMUNITY SPREAD (Students receive remote learning 5 days/week.)

Governor Justice will determine any move to remote learning for a school or county temporarily due to increases in COVID-19 cases impacting the school community.

- Issue communication and resources in advance
• Extend assignment deadlines for flexibility
• Food distribution sites provided in county
• Provide parent/guardian training in Schoology
• Staff to report to buildings daily
• Provide project-based units that incorporate multiple subjects
• Minimize the amount of direct online instruction per day:
Pre-K 60 minutes / day
K - 2 90 minutes / day
3 - 5 120 minutes / day
6 - 8 25 minutes / day / class or 150 minutes / day
9 - 12 30 minutes / day / class or 180 minutes
• Allow reteach and retake on new material
• School-wide protocols for consistency in due date & posts
• Provide logins at the beginning of the year
• Student receives instruction remotely online or other supports

WVDE VIRTUAL LEARNING

Deadline for virtual school registration is September 15, 2020.

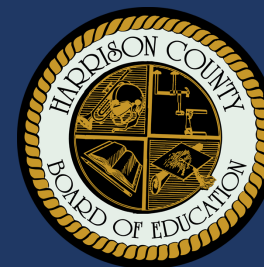
OPTION #2

- Program comprised of online courses presented by facilitators through the WVDE.
• WVDE teachers will provide virtual learning instruction. Harrison County facilitators will maintain contact and provide support:
K-2 students receive contact at least three times per week,
3-8 students receive contact at least two times per week,
9-12 students will receive contact at least once a week.
• Students are eligible for: WVSSAC sports, school nutrition program, WVDE Curriculum, and high school credit.
• WVDE Virtual School is free to all Harrison County students.
• Reliable home internet access is the responsibility of the family.
